JUDGMENT ORDER

April 13, 2007.

After a three day trial, the jury returned a verdict for plaintiff on all counts. Based on the jury verdict, the Court will award damages as set forth below.

As to Count One, the jury found that defendant violated the Federal Communications Act § 605(a). The jury found two violations. Under section 605(C)(i)(II) of the statute, plaintiff may recover damages of not less than \$1,000 and no more than \$10,000 for each violation, as the court considers just. The court will award \$ 1,000 per violation, for a total of \$ 2,000 in damages for Count One.

As to Count Two, the jury found that defendant violated the Federal Communications Act § 605(e)(4). The jury found two violations. Under section 605(C)(i)(II) of the statute, plaintiff may recover damages of not less than \$10,000 and no more than \$100,000 for each violation, as the court considers just. The court will award \$10,000 per violation, for a total


of \$20,000 in damages for Count Two.

As to Count Three, the jury found that defendant violated the Electronic Communications Privacy Act, §§ 2511, 2520. The jury found that defendant violated this statute a total of 477 days. Under section 2520(c)(2)(B) of the statute, plaintiff may recover statutory damages of \$100 a day for each day of violation or \$10,000, whichever is greater. After assessing damages of \$100 per day for 477 days, plaintiff is entitled to \$47,700 in damages under this statute.

As to Count Four, the jury found that defendant violated Pennsylvania statute 18 Pa.C.S. § 910. The jury found three violations. Under this statute, plaintiff is entitled to damages of no less than \$250 and \$10,000 per violation, to be awarded by the court as it considers just. The court will award \$250 per violation, for a total amount of \$750 for this claim.

The total amount of damages from all four counts is \$70,450.
